**Cost: \$24,000**

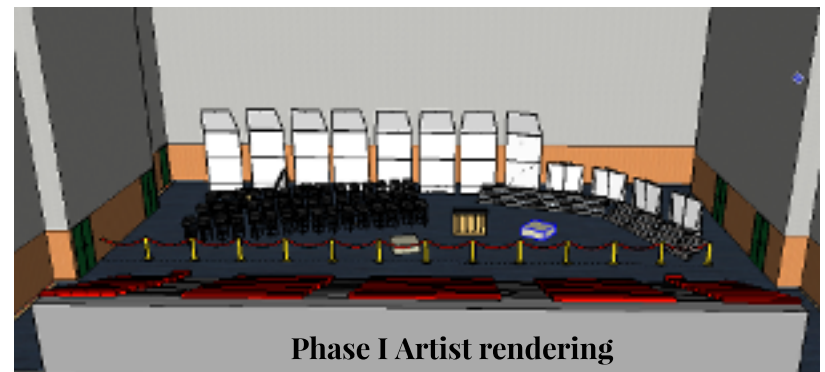


### ***Carpet Squares Floor Covering (By***

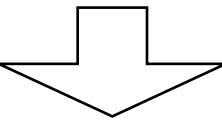
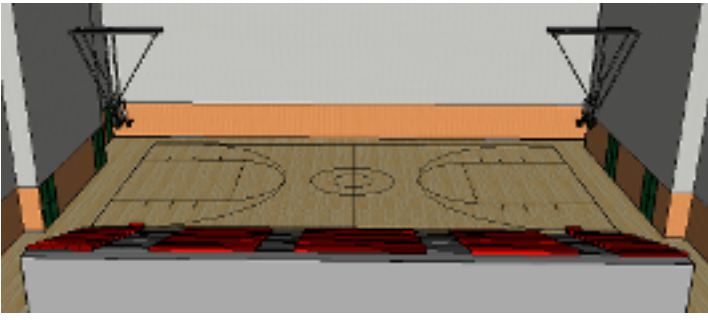
**Cost: \$10,750**

First Phase Estimated Cost: \$35,000

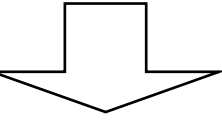

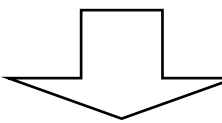
