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THE SCHOOL

Washtenaw International High School (WIHI) is a 9th-12th grade consortium public high school serving students and school districts in Washtenaw County, MI, including Ann Arbor, Chelsea, Lincoln, Manchester, Milan, Saline, Whitmore Lake, Ypsilanti and surrounding school districts. WIHI students participate in a rigorous International Baccalaureate curriculum.

THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAM

All WIHI students pursue the full IB Diploma. The IB program's comprehensive courses, student-centered emphasis, exceptional academic standards and inquiry-based curriculum offer an exemplary education based on international standards.

WIHI SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS AND RECOGNITION

- Top test scores - six times ranked atop Washtenaw County and top-10 in Michigan for SAT & College Readiness Scores
- Five semifinalists and three commended students in the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Competition (Six percent of WIHI competitors, compared to three percent recognized nationwide)
- More than 90 percent of students participate in extra-curricular activities, including interscholastic athletics; home-grown clubs like Diversity Alliance, Black Student Union and Student Government; plus chapters of Model UN, NHS, HOSA and more!

COMMUNITY

WIHI serves students from school districts in Washtenaw County, home to The University of Michigan in Ann Arbor and Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. The county's population is approximately 359,000 people who are employed in a diverse array of medical, technological, manufacturing and educational fields. WIHI is a diverse and inclusive community with students representing a wide range of races, religions and socioeconomic backgrounds. Students speak more than 25 languages at home. No single race represents more than 34 percent of the senior class. 21 percent of WIHI seniors are identified as economically disadvantaged.

IB DIPLOMA PROGRAM COMPONENTS

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Program is a two-year, college-level course of study. Students study IB English Literature, IB Mathematics, IB Science, IB Individuals & Societies, IB Language Acquisition, and an additional IB subject of their choosing. At least three IB examinations are taken at higher level (HL), the remaining three at standard level (SL). The IB Diploma is awarded by the International Baccalaureate Organization to all students who meet the IB requirements and earn qualifying scores on the examinations. The IB Diploma is recognized as one of the most rigorous high school curricula in the world. WIHI students also complete the IB Creativity, Action, and Service (CAS) Program and the IB Extended Essay (EE). The EE is a 4,000-word independent, self-directed research essay.

GRADING AND COVID-19 DISRUPTION

WIHI uses a 4.0 grading scale and provides two cumulative GPAs on transcripts – an unweighted GPA and a weighted GPA. Courses marked “IB” on transcripts are weighted, with additional points averaged in to the weighted GPA. Our school building was closed from March 13, 2020 through April 5, 2021. From March through June 2020, WIHI students completed emergency distance learning courses (“P” grades on transcripts indicate that credit was awarded). The full 2020-21 school year was taught on Zoom.
