### **Courtyard restoration project- update- Vnuk-Kronick/ Bezrutch**

Kim has diagrams displayed on her computer to show the courtyard renovation plan. This is to be used for a senior space and relieve the cafeteria crowding when weather permits. Plantings, hard ground cover, tables, umbrellas and stage are planned for this courtyard. Money for benches tables and umbrellas has been allocated from WEOG. WIHI needs approval from YCS in order to continue with the landscape makeover. This plan has been presented

to the YCS facilities supervisor with the plan including taking all grass out, install limestone surface, and then add handicapped accessible tables, and benches. The construction of a performance stage with a pergola will be a possible enrichment project. A weekend will be scheduled to take out the grass, next a weed membrane will be put down and then native grasses will be planted around the perimeter. The area will be drought tolerant. Robb Kerr rendered drawings and will assist with completion of the area. This project was well received.
